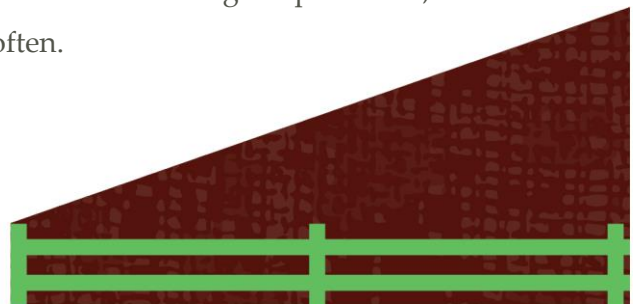

COVID Health Guidelines for Trade Show Attendees

as approved by local health authorities as of 10/2/2020

- **Arrive healthy**
 - no one should attend that feels ill or been around others that have been ill, in process of being tested or have tested positive for COVID-19
- **Be prepared to maintain 6 feet physical distance**
 - See signs about group size limits that may be in effect to comply with current local health directives (currently 8 people)
 - Be considerate of others and **try to walk in a way that allows plenty of distancing from others** that are not in your household e.g. in booth aisles, bathrooms, cafe areas
- **Use of face coverings is required inside buildings at all times** as well as when outside and 6-foot physical distance can't be consistently maintained with people outside your household.
 - See signs on grounds for latest guidance on where face coverings are required
 - Face coverings will be available at entrances for a nominal fee if you need one
 - Face coverings break areas will be provided as much as possible e.g. while seated & distanced or seated and actively eating/drinking—as current DHMs allow.
 - If health reasons don't permit you wearing a face covering, we recommend that you do not attend shows at LEC fairgrounds at this time.
- **Be respectful and comply with any show staff and LEC staff requests**
 - It takes everyone to participate to help run a healthy show
 - Please understand there may be changes at any time based on changing health situation or unique show needs –we are all figuring out how to get back to attending/participating in events safely together.
- **Follow all CDC pandemic health guidelines** to keep yourself and others healthy such as washing/disinfecting hands often, covering sneezes/coughs with your elbow
 - Sanitizer will be provided throughout the show

- If you join us for a show at the LEC fairgrounds, we will do everything we can do to keep everyone as safe as possible but you will acknowledge by entering the grounds that there is no way to guarantee your safety during the COVID-19 pandemic. We strongly encourage folks that are encouraged by local health authorities due to their personal health situation to stay home, please do so.

Our Safety Pledge



- **LEC staff arrive healthy to work** with daily health checks (and temperature checks).
- We work in a way to **maintain 6-foot physical distance**.
- We will help **pre-adjust, communicate and enforce modified show design** to distancing, group size and space capacity limits that reflect current DHM guidelines.
- **We wear face coverings indoors at all times and outside whenever 6-foot physical distancing is unable to be maintained.**
- We will **reduce shared touch surfaces** and disinfect touch surfaces as much as possible e.g. propping open doors.
- We will provide **extra hand sanitizer and/or hand washing stations**.
- We conduct **extra disinfecting of people spaces** throughout the day and overnight e.g. tables, chairs, door handles, counters, etc.
- We will **modify LEC Business Office, Cafe and General Store, show entryway hours and processes** to reduce lines, prolonged in-person interaction and formation of groups e.g. more grab and go food options, more contactless online ticketing services.
- We will provide **more table/chair areas that will be regularly sanitized**, appropriately spaced and each setup for current maximum group sizes e.g. to be able to sit and relax, to eat & drink, to take a face covering break while actively eating and drinking.
- We will **provide signs** to help remind visitors of latest health guidelines and requirements in particular spaces e.g. be healthy to enter, capacity limits in smaller spaces, distancing, etc.
- We will **immediately ask show promoters for assistance** on any health guidelines not being followed.
- **And of course, we will strive to be as friendly and willing as ever to help you have a great show!**
